### 2. POLITICAL MEETINGS

#### - Meeting with the EFAD (European National Agencies) in Berlin: main conclusions

Three people were there to represent ED: Régine Vial (France, Losange), Antonio Medici (Bim, Italy) and Monika Weibel (Frenetic, Switzerland). Around 50 people from European National Agencies attended this meeting. Aviva Silver, Head of MEDIA, was also present.

The reactions of the participants were generally good. The national agencies think that the creation of ED is a good thing for the promotion of European cinema and cultural diversity and that it will encourage the circulation of European works within Europe. Aviva Silver pointed out the support of MEDIA to this initiative from the very beginning because this network represents the practical and political extension of the spirit of the Media program which aims at strengthening the cooperation between European distributors.

Nevertheless, some of the participants (especially from the UK and Germany) underlined the lack of concrete proposals made by Europa Distribution. Concerning the definition of the independent distributor, the participants were rather reluctant (except one or two) because the reality of independent distribution is very different from country to country. Many of them underlined the difficulty to have one definition for all Europe.

The meeting lasted around 30 minutes. Régine Vial introduced the association, Eliane Dubois spoke about the problems and difficulties that distributors have in Europe, Enrique Gonzales spoke about the issues caused by TV channels, and Antonio Medici about the main issues and projects of Europa Distribution.

We thought more ministers will attend, but this little committee was very attentive, and a large summary will be sent to the other ministers.

Viviane Reding congratulated us for the dynamism of Europa Distribution and its actions. She said that the contribution of Europa Distribution during the upcoming discussions on VoD issues was very important. It represents political solutions: VoD must be a chance for distributors and not an obstacle. In October, a meeting of experts will take place under the presidency of Portugal, and Europa Distribution is invited to participate.

She is very pleased with the fact that we plan to organize our first Conference during the San Sebastian film festival, moreover because it is a small European film festival.

- **VOTE ON LINE:** all the members will have the possibility to have access to the decisions made by the committee and to validate or invalidate those decisions.

- **Organisation of the First conference of European distributors in San Sebastian 2007**

- Thanks to Enrique Gonzales Kuhn (Alta – Spain), we have been in contact with the San Sebastian Film Festival (September 19-29) to work on the organization of a meeting of European distributors.
- This meeting will most probably take place during the last WE of the festival (from Friday 28<sup>th</sup> until Sunday 30<sup>th</sup> September) and will focus on 5 main points:
  - **Debates** on common topics (European cinema and multiplexes, the challenge of new technologies...)
  - **Workshops on specific topics** (case studies on up-coming films in different countries, analysis of different local initiatives...)
  - Meeting with Spanish Producers presenting Spanish and European projects looking for financial partners
  - Meeting with Latin-American distributors
  - Presentation of the 3 awarded movies of the festival (Golden Concha, Cine en construccion, New Talent)
