# EFFECTIVE COMMUNICATION IN PROFESSIONAL INTERACTIONS AND IN THE NEGOTIATION PROCESS

#### Content

- Communication and negotiation as a process
- Personality styles and structures in order to adapt to the personalities of others and form strong, durable working relationships as individuals and in teams
- Interaction and negotiation skills in difficult situations and during inevitable periods of stress

#### Methodology

Through theory, exercises, shared experiences and situation analysis, participants will identify the most effective style of communicating and negotiating according to the situation. The training enables participants to:

- Grow in self-understanding: what communication skills do they possess and how to improve them
- Adapt their behavior to match others: accept differences and manage them positively
- Develop assertiveness: communicate so as to be heard in order to avoid misunderstandings, stress and conflict

There is a Festival taxi company called YELLOW TAXI 91119 – Tel. +359 2 91119. They have a desk at the airport. A taxi from the airport to the city centre should not cost more than 10-15 **BGN** (5-8  $\in$ ), and if it is **rush hour no more than 20 BGN** (10  $\in$ ).

ATTENTION: Every taxi in Bulgaria is yellow. Therefore, be careful to choose the company YELLOW TAXI, not a taxi that is yellow. There are a lot of fake taxi cars, so be careful when looking at the rates - every car must have a sign on the bottom left front window with the rates. The usual rate during the day is 0.70-0.90 BGN per kilometre and rate should between 0.5 to 1.5 BGN.

Some of the fake cars have a normal per km rate, but rate may start at 10 or even 20 EUROS. Be careful! Official cars are in front of the west entrance in the arrivals hall. It is simple – the hall is quite small and you should take the right exit after exiting the baggage claim hall.

**GENERAL INFORMATION** 



EXCHANGE

You cannot pay with EUROS or any other currency except from Bulgarian Lev - BGN (at least not officially and it is strongly recommended not to agree to pay anything unofficially)

#### Official rate is 1 BGN for 0,51 EURO

You can pay with a Credit Card in almost every big store, restaurant or club, but this is not customary so please, make sure to ask first

Please note that American Express and Diners Club are quite unpopular in Bulgaria Please **DO NOT exchange** more than 10-15 EUROS at the airport. Exchange rate is shockingly high. It is strongly recommended to exchange your money at the bank ONLY

#### LANGUAGE

Most policemen/policewomen do not speak another language than Bulgarian. The same holds true for people above 50 years old. If you need help you should better ask someone who is between 20 to 45 years old


